The Abstracts have to be written in English and should not exceed two pages. Tables and figures can be included in a text. The accepted abstracts will be distributed in electronic and printed form within conference materials.

Poster presentations:

Posters should be prepared in the maximum size of 1200 x 900 mm. All accepted posters will be displayed during the whole second day of the symposium. Posters will be attached at the allocated position. Organisers will provide technical equipment for mounting of the posters. The work from selected posters will be also presented in form of the short oral presentation during the last session of the conference.

Please note that one presenting author can send only one abstract and present one poster. Every poster need to have separate presenting author.
