Biochemical Laboratory Terms and Conditions

- 1. Pharmaceutical Biochemistry Classroom is open only on days of exercises in designated hours. Students who are not booked for classes and unemployed people are not allowed to enter the classroom.
- 2. Students are required to wear lab coat, safety goggles, gloves and appropriate footwear, during the classes.
- 3. Do not eat, drink or smoke in the classroom, and after completing the exercise, wash your hands thoroughly.
- 4. Hazardous substances should be handled in accordance with the information provided in the instructions for each exercise.
- 5. Acids, bases, organic solvents and materials contaminated with carcinogenic reagents should be disposed of in specially labelled containers.
- 6. Microorganisms and genetically modified materials should be placed in designated containers for inactivation (autoclaving).
- 7. Lab tables, shelves and reagent cabinets should be kept in order. After finishing work, each student is obliged to clean up the place where he worked.
- 8. All used devices should be left turned off and in good order.
- 9. For all random incidents (cuts, burns, etc.), noticed dangers, irregularities or damage (glass breakage, damage to the apparatus) that occurred during the exercise, you should immediately notify the assistant.
- 10. Students are obliged to adhere to other ordinances of the assistant conducting the exercises.
