Additional Criteria for students of DDD applying for master thesis in Chair of Chemical Technology and Biotechnology of Drugs in 2025/26

In the event that there are more applicants for master's theses in the Chair than places granted by the Dean's Office, the priority will be determined by the student's activity in the first year of DDD course, including:

- 1. Student's work in the Department's research projects related to the topic of the master's thesis (including its effects), in the following order:
- a) as a named worker/manager of the project/grant (confirmed by the Project/grant Manager with an indication of current results of the activity achieved)
- b) as part of membership in a scientific student group (SKN) operating at the Chair (confirmed by the SKN Supervisor with an indication of current results of the activity achieved)
- c) as part of volunteering (confirmed by the Project/grant Manager with an indication of current results of the activity achieved)
- 2. In the event of comparable activity (listed in point 1) of students applying for one place, the higher average grade from semester I will be the deciding factor for admission (information on grades is provided by the student).
- 3. In the event that points 1-2 do not provide a clear resolution, the earlier order of entry on the Chair's list (reflecting greater interest) will be decisive.

NOTE! Students meeting the above criteria may be disqualified or redirected to another Supervisor if the number of applicants approved overcome the selected Supervisor's availability or if the chosen DDD pathway is incompatible with the competencies of the Supervisor/Chair.
